



## The Lieutenant Governor's Award for Literary Excellence CRITERIA AND ELIGIBILITY

The Lieutenant Governor's Award for Literary Excellence was established in 2003 by the Honourable Iona Campagnolo to recognize British Columbia writers who have contributed to the development of literary excellence in the Province.

### **Criteria:**

The recipient of the Lieutenant Governor's Award for Literary Excellence will be recognized as having:

- Written a substantial body of literary work throughout their career;
- Contributed significantly to the literary community of the Province.

### **Eligibility:**

1. Writers must be Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents who were born in British Columbia or whose principal place of residence has been British Columbia for the last five (5) full calendar years.
2. Writers who have written books in the following genres will be considered:
  - Fiction
  - Poetry
  - Children's (including young adult fiction)
  - Drama
  - Creative Non-fiction
3. Books may have been published anywhere in the world.
4. Deadline for submissions is 5 p.m. on **Friday, January 15, 2010**
5. The prize will be an award of \$5,000 and a framed certificate.
6. There shall only be one award given each year.
7. Writers will not be awarded posthumously unless they were alive at the time of selection.

### **Nominations:**

Nominations will be accepted from publishers as well as writing and publishing organizations. Nominations consist of a completed Nomination Form and up to ten pages of typed supporting material (one original, plus three copies of the set). There is no limit to the number of nominations an organization can submit. All nominations and their supporting material are considered confidential.

NOTE: If the nominee is not selected for the 2010 award, the nomination will be kept on file for consideration for future awards, for a maximum of three years.

### **Jury:**

The jury shall consist of three prominent figures from the British Columbia literary community. The jury selection will be final.

The award will be presented at the annual Lieutenant Governor's BC Book Prize Gala to be held in Spring 2010.
